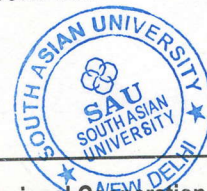

The bidders informed that certain species like Neem and Mango do no survive beyond 10%.	Condition of recovery for mortality more than 20% is being inserted in the NIT/BOQ at item as given below: "If transplanted tree count after 02 years maintenance period is found less than 80%, the recovery shall be made at the rate of Rs.56,000/- per tree for mortality beyond 20%".
4.	P 79, 6.1.42	All agencies inquired about availability of water during plantation and maintenance phase.	Tender conditions are very clear in this regard. SAU does not have any arrangement as of now for water. Hence, the bidder/ contractor has to make arrangement of suitable water of their own.
5.	Cl 3(o) at page 34, cl 6.2.2/p-85, cl 6.5.3 & 6.5.5/page 98 and 6.1.50/P 84. BOQ Item No. 1 of schedule -C/p 120.	The agencies have asked clarifications about the approval required from the Department of Forests	The NOC has been received from the Dept. of Forests, Government of Delhi for removal/ transplantation of 193 trees. A copy of the approval is attached in the NIT, Pg. No:123 to124. However the contractor has to take all the requisite permissions/approvals and do necessary coordination for execution/completion of work including compliance of condition of NOC dated 23 rd June 2020 and submissions as given in NIT.
